Municipal Agent for the Elderly

The Town of Rocky Hill's Municipal Agent for the Elderly is available to Rocky Hill residents 60 years of age and older to help them qualify for local, state, and federal assistance programs. Income/asset eligible seniors can qualify for assistance programs that may improve their quality of life and benefit them financially. Some examples are food stamps, Medicaid, energy assistance, and assistance with Medicare premiums, deductibles and co-pays.

The Municipal Agent for the Elderly has the ability to anonymously input a resident's income and asset information into a computer program to access all assistance benefits the resident may receive.
